- Weekend greeter/Docent:** Greet park visitors and answer questions on weekends.
- Trail Guide/Teacher:** Teach nature lessons to small groups of students on the trails. Experience working with children required. Availability is needed for spring, summer and fall weekdays.
- Office Work/Mailings:** Help the staff with mailings and office projects as needed.
- Gardening:** Cultivating, weeding, grooming plants in our native plant gardens with our gardeners. Availability is needed May through September one morning a week, every other week.
- Special Events:** Assist at events such as the December Holiday Sale and Spring Nature Day.
- Trail Work:** Trail Maintenance is supervised by the NY/NJ Trail Conference. Contact our Land Manager for more information.
- Land Management Research Projects:** Assist with invasive plant species control, erosion control, seasonal plantings, tree work and habitat restoration. Requires moderate physical labor.
- Animal Care:** Help care for our indoor collection of reptiles and amphibians, a year-round task requiring dedication and a love of animals.
